One of the traditional Scripture readings for Advent is about John the Baptist. This year the suggested Lectionary reading for the second Sunday is: "And so John the Baptist appeared in the wilderness, preaching a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins. The whole Judean countryside and all the people of Jerusalem went out to him ... And this was his message: "After me comes the one more powerful than I, the straps of whose sandals I am not worthy to stoop down and untie. I baptize you with water, but he will baptize you with the Holy Spirit." (Mark 1: 4-8)

John the Baptist lived in what some might call a point in history that was a "watershed," or others might say it was a "cross-roads in time." Whatever it was, it was a time when God's time interested our human time.

For almost one hundred years before John, the Roman Empire controlled Israel. And before then Israel had a time of independence when they were not ruled by any nation. It was after the return from exile in Babylon, but there was no King who was the son of David. And the "People of God," remembered what God had promised King David: "When your days are fulfilled and you lie down with your fathers, I will raise up your offspring after you, who shall come from your body, and I will establish his kingdom. He shall build a house for my name, and I will establish the throne of his

shall be made sure forever before me. Your throne shall be established forever." (2 Samuel 7:12-16) The words in the Hebrew for "house" and "descendants" are similar, and so this promise to David was taken to mean that Israel would have a "Son of David" as ruler, forever.

And that lead to the belief that a "messiah," an Anointed One, would come to Israel; and that brings us to the time of Jesus. In his life there was a crossroad in time, or as Paul wrote: "You see, at just the right time, when we were still powerless, Christ died for the ungodly." (Romans 5:6) And: "With all wisdom and understanding, he made known to us the mystery of his will according to his good pleasure, which he purposed in Christ, to

be put into effect when the times reach their fulfillment—to bring unity to all things in heaven and on earth under Christ." (Ephesians 1:8-10) From the moment Jesus was conceived by the Holy Spirit in Mary, to his birth on that first Christmas Eve, to his dying on a cross, and his resurrection---all of that was part of God's "right time." Those thirty plus years was THE watershed event in human history, it was and still is the Cross-road in our time as a people, and as individuals.

A presidential election, coming next year, or a world-wide pandemic, just a few years ago; none of that is even close to what happened in Bethlehem or Jerusalem over 2,000 years ago. The Old Testament Prophet Haggi said: "This is what the Lord Almighty says: 'In a little while I will once more shake the heavens and the earth, the sea and the dry land. I will shake all nations, and what is desired by all nations will come, and I will fill this house with glory,' says the Lord Almighty." (Haggi 2:6-7)

Jesus the Son of God is what/WHO we really desire.

At Christmas we don't just look back to his first coming, we also wait and pray for his second coming. That moment in time when God remakes all into the New Heaven and New Earth; and where: "God's dwelling place is now among the people, and he will dwell with them. They will be his people, and God himself will be with them and be their God. 'He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death' or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away." (Revelation 21: 3-4)

# **Instrumentalist Resignation**


